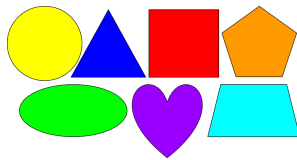
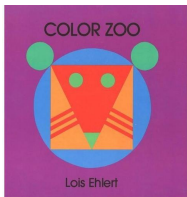


Art Lesson Plans April 6th - 10th
